Legislation Passed During the 2022 Legislative Session	
H 7 OPPORTUNITY ENTERPRISE ACT	The Opportunity Enterprise Act, HB 7, enhances the availability of commercial real estate to support community economic development programs, allowing communities to acquire the necessary space to support local businesses and create jobs.
H 43 CHARTER SCHOOL FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS	HB 43 helps resolve a long-standing issue for New Mexico public charter schools. HB 43 provides loans to charter schools to fund school facilities, including construction, renovation, and paying off lease-purchase agreements. This allows charter schools to have access to public funds for necessary improvements.
H 68 CRIMINAL CODE CHANGES	The House Democrats' comprehensive crime bill, HB 68, will help deter and prevent violent crime to combat the increase in crime that has occurred in recent years. HB 68: - funds 24-hour GPS monitoring of defendants on pretrial release, - cracks down on the market for stolen cars and parts by making it a crime to operate a chop shop, and - eliminates the statute of limitations and increases penalties for second-degree murder. The bill also provides programs for recruiting new officers, retaining current officers, and creating new judgeships in the Albuquerque area.
H 104 VENTURE CAPITAL PROGRAM ACT	The Venture Capital Program Act, HB 104, makes investments in new and expanding businesses. These investments are required to be made with venture private equity funds or with New Mexico businesses in the early stages of development and are funded by \$35 million in the budget.
HM 10 CERTIFIED ANESTHESIOLOGIST ASSISTANTS WEEK	HM 10 supports our healthcare workers. HM 10 declares the second week of June as Certified Anesthesiologist Assistants Week to recognize their stringent and high-quality skills to assist in delivering healthcare services.


